

A Note of Appreciation

"I am one of the fortunate Torontonians that is part of The WoodGreen Foundation COVID-19 weekly grocery plan. I wanted to take a moment and thank the foundation and your donors for this necessary service during these surreal times.

"The grocery program could not have come at a better time for me and my household. I am one of the contract workers who has sadly fallen between the cracks in the federal government's relief packages. My husband (also a senior citizen) and I had been relying on our local food bank.

"With our limited budget, we live in a neighbourhood that is considered 'sketchy' at the best of times. Since the government 'stay at home' orders, the corner has turned from 'undesirable' to darn right scary. All the regulars (pan handlers, homeless individuals, working ladies) are nowhere to be seen, replaced by only gangs and drug dealers. It reached the point that if I had to leave the apartment I felt in a very vulnerable position. The criminal community feeds on weakness and I began to feel I was a likely target. With this in mind, I made the decision that it was not safe for me to make the two block walk to the food bank.

I am honoured to share this report, which offers just a sampling of the vital assistance made possible to date, through your #COVID19commitment. Food Security

Your extraordinary support — through financial contributions, in kind donations and community partnerships — allowed us to respond to the wide-spread and urgent need to provide emergency groceries and prepared meals as well as household supplies for a growing number of at-risk clients. Through your generosity, we have been able to assist:

- Seniors unable to leave their homes to shop for groceries while self-isolating, with no family to shop for them
- Individuals who had been living paycheque to paycheque, now suddenly out of work with no money for food
- People who previously had relied on food banks that had now been forced to close or were stretched beyond capacity
- Families who had previously relied on school meal programs to help meet their children's nutritional needs


Your generosity has also allowed us to provide thousands of masks for our tenants and clients in the broader community, to help prevent the spread of the virus.

Personal Wellness


The support of our generous individual, corporate and foundation donors enabled us to provide clients of all ages with specialized packages to meet a variety of needs, including:

WoodGreen staff pivoted quickly to deliver programs and services remotely in order that our clients could continue to receive crucial support while still complying with social distancing requirements. However a number of our clients did not have the technology required to gain access to these programs — nor to connect with the outside world while they were self-isolating.

- Enable seniors and other clients to receive virtual support including mental health counselling, seniors day programs, employment help, English language training, etc.
